



Linden Place Photography Pass

A Photography pass and appointment are required for any professional photography sessions and for the use of additional professional equipment like tripods, lighting, etc.

Professional photographers may purchase a Photography Pass for \$200. Each Photography Pass is valid for one year and provides the photographer with the following benefits:

- Unlimited standard admission to the mansion and grounds you and your household (2 adults and your children or grandchildren under the age of 18), and for the subjects of your photo shoots on the day of their session.
- Unlimited photography sessions such as engagement sessions, family portraits, senior portraits, head shots, first communion, prom, maternity, and any other posed portrait sessions during normal operating hours and on the grounds on weekends during daylight hours. (All photography sessions must be scheduled in advance. No photography sessions will be scheduled at times when the museum is otherwise in use for private or public events.)
- You will be issued a photography membership card. (This must be on your person when on the property for photography sessions and presented to staff or volunteers upon request.)
- Members rates on the purchase of tickets to programs and events.
- 15% discount in the gift shop
- Admission to members-only programs and events
- Subscription to the Linden Place newsletter

Photography Passes are non-refundable and are subject to the terms and conditions and general photography policies listed below.

Terms and Conditions:

- All photography sessions must be scheduled in advance by calling the office at (401) 253-0390 or emailing info@lindenplace.org
- All photography sessions are subject to availability.
- All photographers are required to check in at the gift shop
- Photographers and their subjects are expected to respect the museum and its historic property. All roped-off or marked furniture must be avoided and no furniture or objects within the mansion may be moved. Please do not step in the garden beds or move the urn planters on the grounds. No climbing, sitting, or otherwise putting weight on any of the statues.
- The maximum in a group is 6. Larger groups may be considered on a case by case basis.
- Sessions must be completed by 5 PM on weekdays unless special arrangement for evening hours has been made, and by sunset on weekends.

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- After hours sessions are those after 5pm on weekdays or requiring use of the mansion on weekends. After hours sessions can be arranged at an additional fee of \$100/hr with a maximum of 3 hours per session.
- Photographers must carry their Linden Place Photography Membership card during the entire photo shoot.
- To be eligible for this membership, you must provide us with your professional photography website address.
- Photography Memberships do not include commercial photography sessions such as fashion shoots, advertising, films, and promotional shoots. All commercial photography must be approved and scheduled in advance. To learn more about pricing for commercial photography, please contact info@lindenplace.org
- Photographers who have been hired by a bridal party or other individual that has contracted with Linden Place to rent the venue are not required to have a Photography Membership, but are still expected to adhere to the guidelines for respecting the museum and property.
- Linden Place reserves the right to refuse unscheduled photo sessions.
- Linden Place reserves the right to cancel a Photography Membership if photography policies and/or general visitation policies are not followed.
- All fees are non-refundable.

General Photography Policies:

- Photography must not interfere with the visiting experience of other guests at Linden Place.
- Specific locations must not be blocked off for a photo shoot. Photographers should expect the need to work around visitors. The staff are able to recommend low visitation times when you schedule your session, but the visiting public will not be turned away if they come during your session. To ensure no visitors during your session, schedule an after hours session.
- Moving or removing structures that are part of the museum, such as planters, statues, signs, displays, etc. is strictly prohibited.
- No photographer or subject may climb or mount equipment in trees or structures.
- Balloons, kites, flying lanterns, and confetti are prohibited. Please contact the office to gain approval for any props you would like to use.
- All photo subjects must be fully and appropriately clothed. Swimsuit photo shoots are not permitted.
- All cords, wires, or equipment must be placed and guarded in a way that doesn't alter the pathways or put museum visitors at risk.
- Photographers will be held accountable for their actions and those of their clients, crew members, and subjects if they damage Linden Place facilities and property.
- No photographs may be taken of visitors outside of the party you are shooting.
- Photos must not conflict with the values and mission of Linden Place.
